

Articles of Incorporation  
Of  
Howard County Citizens Association, Inc.

This is to certify:

First: We, the undersigned Seymour Barondes, whose post office address is 29 Dellwood Avenue, Ellicott City, Maryland; James Bell, Mac Alpine Road, Ellicott City, Maryland; Thelma Romaser, R.F. 1; Belgaro Road, Laurel, Maryland, each being at least twenty-one years of age, do hereby associate ourselves as incorporators with the intention of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the General Laws of the State of Maryland.

Second: That the name of the Corporation (which is hereinafter called the Corporation) is Howard County Citizens Association, Inc.

Third: The purposes for which the Corporation is formed and the business or object to be carried on or promoted by it are as follows:

- (1) To unite the various civic, community and improvement associations and interested individual citizens of Howard County in joint efforts for their mutual benefits and for the advancement of the best interests of the residents of County.
- (2) To take joint and cooperative action for:
  - a. Improvement of county government
  - b. orderly growth and development of the county in the best interest of the residents
  - c. the development of sound fiscal policies and responsible administration of public funds
  - d. improvement of county services and facilities
  - e. the preservation of agricultural and recreational areas in the county.

Fourth: The post office address of the place at which the principal office of the Corporation in this State will be located is 24 Dellwood Avenue, Ellicott City, Maryland. The resident agent of the corporation is Seymour Barondes whose post office address is 24 Dellwood Avenue, Ellicott City, Maryland. Said resident agent is a citizen of the State of Maryland and actually resides therein.

Fifth: The number of directors of the Corporation shall be three (3) which may be increased or decreased pursuant to the by-laws of the Corporation, but shall never be less than three, and the names of the directors who shall act until the first annual meeting or until their successors are duly chosen and qualified are as follows: Seymour Barondes, James Bell and Thelma Romaser.

Sixth: The members shall pay such dues and fees as shall be determined from time to time by the By-laws. The Corporation shall have no capital stock.

Seventh: The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.
