Once again the Howard County Citizens Association, HCCA is disappointed that when it comes to Forest Conservation only Council members Liz Walsh and Deb Jung consistently are doing their best to ensure our remaining mature trees are protected. An example is last evening when Liz Walsh's bill, CB30 was defeated by a 3 to 2 vote with Council Member Jung as usual supporting Forest Conservation. Council Members, Jones, Rigby and Yungmann said "No."

The Bill was for amending the purpose of the Forest Conservation Act of Howard County; altering the definition of a forest; increasing certain reforestation calculations; amending qualification for the use of certain forest mitigation banks; and generally related to the Forest Conservation Act of Howard County.
