- 1. Treasurer report and minutes were approved.
- 2. Treasurer transition was discussed.
- 3. Board Membership and by laws revisions were discussed for further consideration.
- 4. HCCA testimony.
 - a. CB61. Stu Kohn was authorized to testify for HCCA.
 - b. Discussed Maryland HB 1450 Task Force on education funding.
 - c. The December 2nd County Council legislative session was discussed.
- 5. APFO. Review is at early stages. Time line was reviewed. HCCA will continue to follow the task force.
- 6. Brian England discussed watershed protection. Columbia Association watershed protection is environmentally counterproductive. Civil engineers, activists and others have documented harmful activities. Open space needs reevaluation to accomplish protection and preservation.
- 7. The Long Reach redevelopment plan was discussed.
- 8. Zoning: Proposed approval for WR Grace to conduct testing of plastic burning. Residents in neighboring villages are complaining that air and water protections are required.
- 9. Zoning: A go kart track has been built without compliance with zoning laws and regulations. The Greater Highland Crossroads Association supports compliance with zoning laws HCCA supports compliance and enforcement.
- 10. Karina Fisher reported on school budget capital and operational procedures and issues. Adequate funding, the budge process, and selection of schools for capital funding are issues.
- 11. Archives. Discussed preservation of HCCA archives.
