- 5. MD HB44-25 Chao Wu sponsored to allow non-partisan Judge elections. HCCA testified in favor, mentioned the large number of independents.

- 7. County hearing on local bills, Feb. 19. HCCA will testify on CB11. Stu is going in person. Expected to be very crowded.
- 8. Cap on MIHU Fee-in-lieu and building excise tax rates Deb Jung asked to meet with Lisa on this. Lisa will keep Board posted.
- MD HB960-25 Board voted to have Paul Verchinski provide draft testimony to support removal of lobbying costs from electric company expense/rate calculations. MD HB 1035-24 – HCCA Board authorized Paul Verchinski to draft testimony that facilitating financing nuclear projects should entail more review and pilot projects.

- 10. HCCA Archives Paul V. and Brian met with Historical Society located in Miller Library. They agreed to house physical archives. HCCA Board voted to give donation in the amount of \$250. Brian will follow up.
- 11. Possible new Board candidate Stu will speak to Ryan Powers to explore.
